

P.S.E.D

We will be learning about being healthy. We will be exploring how we can keep our bodies healthy and understand how moving and resting are good for our bodies. We will be learning about foods which are healthy and not so healthy so that we can make healthy eating choices.

We will also be learning about the importance of hygiene and getting lots of sleep!

Communication and Language

We will think of questions to ask visitors that come into school to share experiences of their jobs.

We will be using language to imagine and recreate roles in our 'vets' role play area.

Physical Development

We will develop our fine motor skills with our finger challenges and practice forming our letters correctly.

In PE, we will be developing our negotiating space skills through our sessions with Newcastle Sports Service. We will also be developing our gymnastics skills this half term. We will be experimenting with different ways of moving and rolling in different ways with control.

Literacy

We will be acting out the story 'We're going on an egg hunt', as well as labelling a story map.

We will also read non-fiction books to find out about the different jobs people do.

We will be applying our phase 2 and 3 phonic knowledge to write labels and captions linked to the stories we are reading in class.

We will continue to apply our growing phonic knowledge to read words and sentences.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about how different people who help us in our community.

We will be talking about signs of new life on a farm during spring time.

We will be using google Earth to compare the difference between the town where we live and the countryside.

We will be learning about Easter and how this festival is celebrated.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be using junk-modelling materials to make emergency vehicles.

We will paint pictures of different people who help us.

We will be using natural objects to create own art work, linked to the artist 'Andy Goldsworthy'.

We will be printing patterns during our Easter craft activities.

Mathematics

We will be exploring the composition of and representation of numbers 9 and 10, developing the understanding that that all numbers are made up of smaller numbers. We will also continue our work on combining 2 groups.

We will be comparing numbers within 10, using key vocabulary more than and fewer than. We will also be exploring number bonds to 10 using real objects in different contexts.

We will be exploring and manipulating 3D Shapes as well as exploring more complex patterns.
