Non Uniform and Birthdays

We have a long standing tradition at Broadway East/Havannah of celebrating every birthday. We also give children birthday claps and stickers in achievers' assembly in the week of their birthday (or as close as possible). Picking up from Clubs and School Security

To pick up children from extra-curricular clubs at the end of the day, please wait at the front of school and the club provider will bring the children to the main door or the community room door and safely hand them over. The club provider will be able to open the gate for you to pick up bikes and scooters if they are inside the secure line of the school.

To pick up from Gosforth out of School Club (wrap around), please come to the usual door on the side of the building. The club staff will be able to unlock the gate for you if you need to pick up bikes and scooters.

Head Bump Texts

When children in school have a head bump, even when they are not hurt, we send you a text to let you know. This is so that you can keep an eye on them later on and spot any signs of concussion. Please don't be alarmed if you receive one of these texts. If we are concerned that your child is hurt, unwell or showing any signs of concussion while at school, we will ring you immediately.

Admissions

The admissions process is now open for children who are due to start school in September 2023. You need to apply by 15th January 2023 through Newcastle City Council
