ENGLISH Grimm's Fairy Tales

During this topic, the children will explore fairy tales, discussing common themes whilst working on fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases, paragraphing and speech punctuation. The children will write a short story from a different characters point of view.

Recounts/Journalistic Writing

<u>History</u> Who first lived in Britain?
