Castles, Seaside and Pirates:

This term our topics are Traditional Tales, followed by the Seaside and Pirates. We will be reading stories including:

- What the Ladybird Heard at the Seaside
- The Night Pirates
- The Rainbow Fish

We will creating story maps, writing descriptions and instructions.

We will be investigating materials, programming Beebots and learning about safety at the Seaside.

This half term, we are having a big focus on tricky words, these are the words that children cannot sound out.
