Play Scripts

<u>History</u> Who first lived in Britain?



In History this half term, we will be learning about the first people who lived in Britain, exploring the changes that occurred from the Stone Age up to the Iron Age. We will look at the historical sources of evidence that are available from this period and evaluate their limitations.





In Science this half term, we will identify igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic rocks. When we have a clear understanding of the three rock types, we will be developing our understanding of how they are formed. We will also investigate how rocks are crucial in the formation of soil. Finally, we will be learning about Mary Anning and the impact she made in the world of palaeontology.
