People Who Help Us & Amazing Animals

Our topic to start off this half term is People Who Help Us. We will start off by finding out about people who help us in our local area. This will range from the emergency services to construction workers to mums/dads/grandparents/carers at home! We will be inviting volunteers to come into school and share their job roles with us. We are also very excited about our Amazing Animals topic. Our classroom role play areas will transform into Veterinary Surgeries. We will be exploring and learning more about different types of animals in more detail each week, including pets. We will also have a big focus on farm animals which will be very exciting and useful in preparing us for our upcoming trip to Hall Hill Farm later this month.

Reading

The children are continuing to impress us with their brilliant progress with reading this year. Thank you so much for your support in listening to them read regularly and helping them to learn the sounds and words in their sound books. As well as the structured teaching of reading that the children receive at school, sharing their home reader with you, gives them the opportunity to put these skills into practise. So, thank you for your continued support in hearing your child read at home. We cannot stress strongly enough how important this is. Reading daily with your child, as well as sharing stories with them, is the single biggest and most important thing you can do to help your child's learning. Please continue to sign your child's reading diary if they have read at home, it is always useful for staff to hear how the children have read at home. Our reading days will be staying the same for this half term and we will continue to collect decodable books (reading practice books) on a Monday and send new ones on a Thursday. Although we only change books on a Thursday, please ensure reading books and diaries are in book bags every day so that adults in school can read with your child. Thank you for your support with sound books. We can really see the impact of regularly practising these sounds and tricky words at home too.
